- 1. Due to COVID-19, Hong Kong Kart Club refer to the news released by the Center for Health Protection and take appropriate measures, participants must take body temperature before each class and put on their masks during the course.
- 2. Applicants and parents and legal guardian must make sure that he/she is physically fit and suitable to participate in such course, and ensure the information filled in the application is true and correct.
- 3. Once the application has been accepted, applicants will not be allowed to change his/her entry to another person or to have any of his/her entry fee refunded. Unless the course canceled or revised, all the payment will not be refunded.
- 4. HKKC has insured the public liabilities insurance. Applicants should arrange the necessary insurance according to the needs, such as accidental injury and death insurance and property protection insurance.
- 5. Applicants must follow all instructions of the Course-in-charge or officials during the course, and must notify them in case of sickness.
- 6. Course-in-charges or officials have the rights to refuse the applicants to continue participating in the course due to lack of discipline or any other reasons, all the payment will not be refunded.
- 7. Hong Kong Kart Club have the rights to accept and reject any application without any explanations.
- 8. Applicants shall take responsibility for their own belongings. The Club shall not be liable for any loss or damage. It is highly recommended that not to bring the valuables attending the course.
- 9. The event will be cancelled if Typhoon Signal no.8 or above is hoisted and/or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal is issued. The reschedule class will be announced later.
- 10. Course-in-charge shall decide whether or not to continue at the latest two hours before the course according to the actual weather conditions. Course will be normal if there is no announcement.
